HARVARD SUMMER SCHOOL (HSS) SEOUL, KOREA PROGRAM (STUDY ABROAD)

The HSS-Korea Program runs from late June-mid/late August; half the class on the program is comprised of local Korean university students. Focus is on Korean Language (all levels) and a content course. In 2027, the content class will be a Sociology class. Both classes are required. The program is based at Ewha Womans University (co-ed in the summer.) No Korean language pre-requisite. HARVARD COLLEGE SUMMER FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES OFFICE (SFO)

On the HSS online program application, you will be asked if you are a Harvard College student and for your HUID. Following will be a checkbox question asking if you'd like to be included in the SFO funding lottery. Be careful not to overlook this and do check this box this to be considered for SFO Summer Funding for an HSS study abroad program.



KI SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE HSS-SEOUL, KOREA PROGRAM

KI Scholarships are due the same date as the HSS Program application is due. The 2027 deadline is **January 28, 2027**. Please visit the KI Webpage for the KI HSS in Korea Program Scholarship funding information and specific application process for this KI Scholarship.

EWHA-EISC PROGRAM (EWHA WOMANS UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL CO-ED SUMMER COLLEGE) (STUDY ABROAD) OR

SNU-ISP PROGRAM (SEOUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL STUDY PROGRAM) (STUDY ABROAD)

Online applications are due on CARAT February 8, 2027.

These two study abroad programs are 4-5 weeks long.

EWHA-EISC PROGRAM - Students must take at least 1 Korean language course and 1 content class in English or 1 Korean language course. You may not take 2 Korean language courses. If selected, tuition is paid for. Student will receive a KI funding award for the flight cost (up to a max amt). Student must arrange and pay for their own flight from the KI award. Student is also responsible for dorm cost, meals, and general living expenses. No Korean language pre-requisite. Please see more details on the KI website.

SNU-ISP PROGRAM - Students may take 1 Korean class and 1 content class in English or 2 content classes in English. If selected, tuition and dorm costs are paid for. Student will receive a KI funding award for the flight cost (up to a max amt). Student must arrange and pay for their own flight from the KI award. Student is also responsible for meals and general living expenses. No Korean language pre-requisite. Please see more details on the KI website.





KI SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN SEOUL, KOREA (INTERNSHIPS) [STILL TBC FOR SUMMER 2027]

Online applications are due on CARAT February 8, 2027. There will be interviews for finalists. Program is 8 weeks long. Internships require solid background in the Korean language, with a minimum requirement of conversational fluency (2 years) and higher levels of fluency is preferred. Returning Harvard students are highly preferred. If selected, interns must arrange and pay for their own flight, dorm costs and living and commuting expenses from the KI funding award. This is not a paid internship and the KI award may not cover all costs. Housing will be in a dormitory based at Ewha Womans University. Our intern host organizations (*still to be confirmed*) are likely at CJ Corporation affiliates: CJ ENM (CJ Entertainment and Merchandising) and CJ Cultural Foundation. Subject to change. UNDERGRADUATE SUMMER RESEARCH TRAVEL GRANTS TO KOREA (RESEARCH)

Online applications are due on CARAT February 8, 2027. Korea Institute Undergraduate Summer Travel Grants are awarded to Harvard undergraduates in the humanities or social sciences to use in Korea for research and/or fieldwork relating to a senior honors thesis in an area of Korean studies. Ordinarily, the award covers the cost of travel and research related expenses for the research project. **Typically, undergraduate applicants must have at least two years of Korean language training or equivalent proficiency in the language.** In the case of exceptionally strong projects, more limited language background may be considered. UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH ASSISTANTSHIPS FOR KOREA (RESEARCH)

The 2027 deadline is February 28, 2027. Details on the KI website on how to apply. The Korea Institute will offer hybrid Research Assistantships for Korea focused projects supervised by Harvard faculty for summer 2027. There is typically a range of opportunities for Harvard undergraduates to work on faculty research projects in a variety of capacities. RAs are a great opportunity for students with little research experience to get hands-on exposure to the research world. Work is arranged and directed by faculty members, who will directly supervise student RAs. The student and faculty member discuss and clarify in advance the research responsibilities and outcomes. Students may assist with data collection, data analysis, literature reviews, or other aspects of a faculty project. If awarded a KI Research Assistantship, students are paid \$20/hour (up to \$2,000 total summer stipend per Assistantship via weekly student payroll if all work is completed.) over 5-10 weeks, based on the needs of the faculty project. Korean language requirements vary. Listings of 2027 faculty projects should be on the KI website updated beginning in January.
