CINEMA KOREA:

Engaging Korean History Through Film

JUNE 24 - AUGUST 17, 2013

Examine Korea's contemporary and historical place in the world through the lenses of cinema and Korean history, combining the critical study of seminal films with practical training in documentary filmmaking. Students will create films engaging and expanding the larger themes explored in class screenings, readings and during a series of visits to major cultural and historic sites across Korea. AV equipment and editing software are provided, and students need not have prior experience with either film or Korean language.

In addition to the course on Korean film, students will study Korean language for credit. Multi-track instruction in Korean language reinforces language skills and enriches students' understanding of Korean culture.
