COURSES: GLOBAL KOREA

Global Korea will explore Korea's role in global events and processes during the 20th and 21st Centuries. Topics will include (i) conflict, war, and empire; (ii) economics, politics, industry, and enterprise; (iii) migration, multiculturalism, and diaspora; (iv) media, entertainment, and innovation. The course will ground readings and discussion about these global processes through immersive, engaging experiences in Seoul and throughout South Korea.

MULTI-TRACK KOREAN LANGUAGE INSTRUCTION

In addition to the Global Korea course, students will study Korean language for credit. Multi-track instruction in Korean language reinforces language skills and enriches students' understanding of Korean culture. Students need not have prior experience with Korean language.
